And) 1.common noun:the name of person, place or thing in general is known as common noun.

eg:doctor, city, plants etc.

- 2. Proper noun: The name of particular person, place or thing Is known as a proper noun.
- eg: Jammu, Red Fort, mount Abu, Yamuna etc.
- 3. Collective nouns: A set of group of people, things or animals is known as collective nouns.

eg: a herd of cows, a bunch of keys etc.

- 4. Abstract nouns: The nouns which shows qualities, feelings, ideas or a state of person place or a thing are known as abstract noun.
 - eg: Happiness, poverty, hatred etc
 - 5. countable nouns: the nouns that we count are known as countable nouns
- 6) Uncountable nouns: The nouns which cannot be counted are known as uncountable nouns.

Some Countable nouns are as under:

Bananas, places, cubes, bottles etc.

Some Uncountable nouns are as under:

Rice, wheat, sugar, wood, gold, gases like oxygen, hydrogen etc, childhood, happiness, knowledge, history, geography etc.
