Q1)What is a noun? Give examples.

Ans)The name of person, place, thing or animal is known as noun

eg: Jammu, Riya, table, tiger etc

Q2) What are Abstract nouns? Give examples.

Ans)An abstract noun is a noun that refers to an intangible concept such as an emotion, a feeling, a quality, or an idea.

some examples of feelings that are abstract nouns: love, fear, embarrassment, pride, surprise, etc

Q3)What Is a collective noun? Give examples.

Ans)A noun ' that refers to a group of people or things is known as collective noun

eg: A flight f birds

A herd of sheep

A loaf of bread

A bunch of keys

A pack of thieves

A band of musicians

A team of players

Q4)What are singular nouns? Ans) A singular noun names one person, place, thing, or idea

eg: table, apple, boy, baby etc

Q5)What are plural nouns? Ans) A plural noun names more than one person, place, thing, or idea

eg: tables, apples, boys, babies etc.

Q7) what are adjectives?

Ans)An adjective is a word that describes an animal, person, thing, or thought.

Eg: happy boys, red shirt

Happy and red are adjective words.

Q8) What are adjectives of quantity?

Ans)Adjective of quantity answer the question how much?

Examples are: some, any, little, much, enough, sufficient, insufficient, all, whole, great etc

Q9) What are adjectives of number?

Ans)They answer the question 'how many?'

Example:some, many, few, all, no, several etc.

Q10)What are the adjective of quality?

Ans)An adjective which is used in the sentence to express the size, shape, and color of a person, thing, animal, or place

Examples : clever, honest, black, red, big, round etc.

Q11) What are demonstrative adjectives?

Ans) Demonstrative adjectives modify specific nouns and include this, that, these, and those. This and that are used for singular nouns. These and those for plural nouns.

Examples: Give me that blue water bottle.

This time I won' t fail you.

I want those gorgeous marbles.

I wanted to propose you that day.

These mangoes are rotting.

Q12) What are possessive adjectives?

Ans) The possessive adjectives are my, your, his, her, its, our, their, and whose.

Means it shows belongingness.

Eg: my hat

His duty

Their job etc.
